

ALL ABOUT ME

You are going to learn how to use the Yearbook Program by creating a page called "All about Me."

- 1. Go to: Create...Page Ladder and find the page with your name on it. Click on the page.**
- 2. IMMEDIATELY go to "FILE...New Practice Page" and name your document: ALL ABOUT ME-LAST NAME**
- 3. Work on your page as directed in class. Don't forget to save!**

You will be learning about the various things you can do on a page layout. In order to accomplish this, you will be creating a page all about yourself.

Your page should have the following:

- A layout created with intent
- Ten uploaded photos... at least five of these should have you in them
You may or may not be in the other photos, but they should show aspects of your life/personality.
- You should have at least four aspects of your life/personality that you are highlighting in this layout.
- Your name should be incorporated into the design of the layout
- You should include a short paragraph about yourself. Please include your name, age, and four areas of interest in your life that are reflected in your photo choices.

Some things to remember: The purpose of this assignment is to learn to use the Yearbook Avenue Tools, so please explore as much as you can! Also... neatness, clarity/choice of photos, spelling, punctuation, grammar, spacing, placement, and alignment are all important. I will be looking at your use of color and white space as well.

- 4. To find your page again later, go to CREATE...Page Designer, and be sure that "DESIGN" is selected. From the dropdown menu on the right, choose CUSTOM...Practice Pages and find your page.**
- 5. To work on your practice page, click on the blue "i" and then click on edit.**
