

Part 1: Listening – Be able to tell when the speaker is talking about a boy or a girl.

Part 2: You will be writing three paragraphs, and one interview.

Paragraph 1: Talk about yourself.

Paragraph 2: Talk about a male relative.

Paragraph 3: Talk about a female relative

Interview: You will have to ask questions.

For paragraph 1, you will need to be able to state name, age, nationality, where you are from, what nationality you are NOT, and a description of yourself, including eye color. Be able to say what you want for your birthday.

For paragraphs 2-3, you will have to write all about a boy and a girl (see above), and you will have to say his/her relation to you.

For the interview, you will need to be able to find out someone’s name and age, and also ask, “Are you (nationality)?”

Part 3: You should be able to answer any of the “French Speaking World” questions about the five countries/regions we studied. **These will NOT be matching. You will have to write down the answers.** You can practice on Quizlet, and you can also study from the practice quiz I gave out in class.
