Students who choose to make a collage must have access to a color printer.

Students who choose to make a collage MUST do the country they were assigned because they will be using their research fact sheets.

For the other project choices, students can do any of the five countries/regions: Haiti, Martinique, Switzerland, Tunisia, Québec. Students interested in a completely different French-speaking country or region can request permission.

Project choices – Le Monde Francophone - KEEP THIS SHEET !

1. **J'adore la nourriture (I love food)** Your food should be “typical” of the place you are studying. Just because the recipe has the word “Canadian” or “Swiss” in it, does not make it so. Try to find a website that is dedicated to food from the place you are studying. The food does not have to be an “everyday food,” it just has to be from the place you’ve studied.

- Turn in a recipe by 12/4 from one of the five places we studied. I will give you the okay.
- Food from your country cooked for class + plates, napkins, serving utensils, etc... for your food: 12/11

2. **Je suis créatif/créative (I am creative)** Create a poster collage of your country. Your poster collage should be thoughtful, and your pictures and facts spread neatly throughout. It should not just be a collection of pictures pasted on a paper. You must have an outside border of some kind on your collage. Please also consider putting borders around pictures and/or facts. Your facts should be spread used artistically and in an interesting manner. You do not need captions on the pictures. In order to do this project, you need access to a printer.

- Poster should be shaped like something symbolic for your country other than the flag (not a rectangle, square, etc...). Ex: National bird / common food / popular sports item. Tell me by 12/4 the shape of your project.
- Make a poster collage of your country/region in color with your facts dispersed throughout (facts are the ones we looked up together in class).
- A flag and a map of your country on the poster (in color).
- A minimum of 10 other color pictures / pictures are varied

Je suis chanteur/chanteuse (I am a singer)

- Submit a copy of what you will be singing by 12/4. THE SONG MUST BE IN FRENCH and must come from one of the places we are studying.
- Come to class on 12/15 ready to sing. Song must show evidence of practice.

Je suis peintre (I'm a painter)

- Send me a picture in advance of the scene you wish to paint by 12/4. The scene must be from a place we are studying.
- Bring in your painting by 12/15.

It is your job to respect the timelines on each project and to plan accordingly. Please submit required information on the website as we discussed in class. Look at your individual project for details. Once you get on the website, it should be obvious how to submit items for each project. Be awesome! Be “wow!”
